

TLC/Engrade FAQs

What is TLC/Engrade?

TLC/Engrade is a platform that offers a variety of applications for the classroom. It permits teachers to "manage daily activities, integrate curriculum content from a variety of sources, and deploy and score assessments that teachers enter into the system."

How will teachers use TLC/Engrade?

Teachers will use three modules of this platform, Teach, Corebook, and Assess, as a learning management system (LMS) with their students. The Teach module allows teachers to search digital assets and assign them to students. Corebook provides a transactional platform for teachers to assign, collect and correct student work online. In the Assess module, teachers can create formative assessments using a variety of question formats. The assessments can be computer or teacher scored.

How will students use TLC?

Students can access assignments, complete assessments, turn in assignments, and communicate with teachers through the TLC/Engrade platform. If assignments or assessments are machine scored, students can receive immediate feedback.

What is the expectation for teachers' use of TLC/Engrade?

This school year is a building year for TLC/Engrade. Teachers are expected to get to know the system through professional development, learn to create assignments and push them out to students, and create a few formative assessments, such as warm-ups and exit tickets.
